The assembly was a meaningful tribute, encouraging young learners to carry forward Guru Nanak Dev Ji's legacy of selfless service and moral integrity.

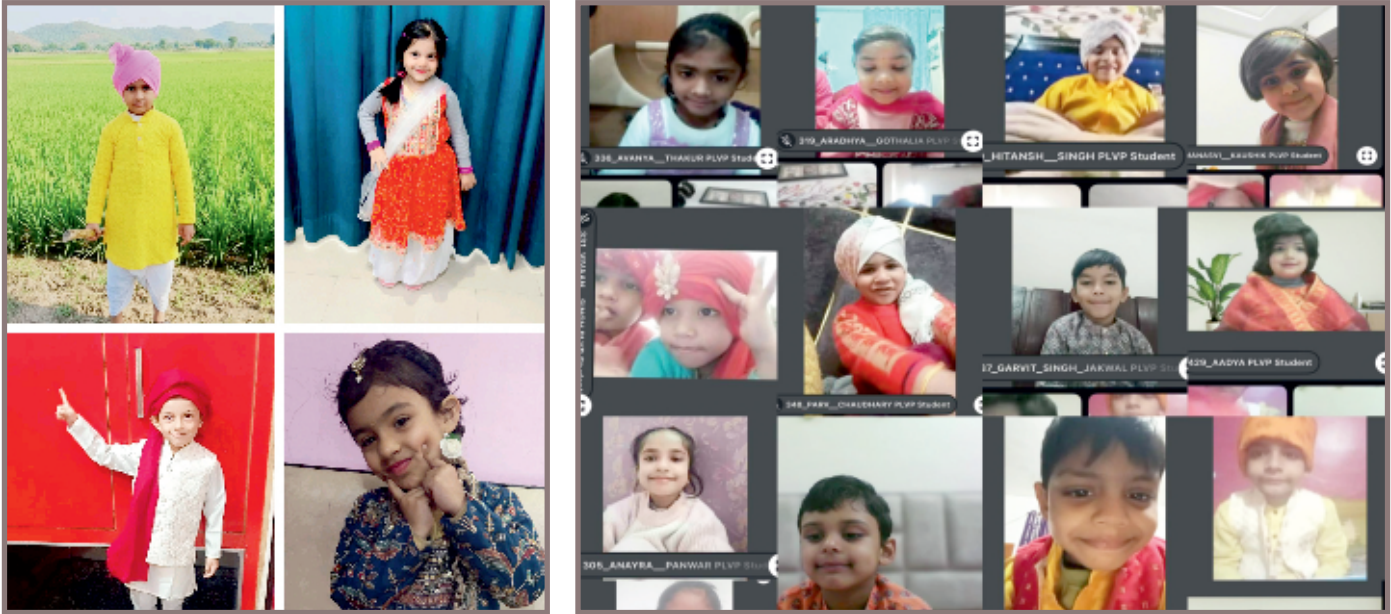


## LOHRI LIGHTS UP SCREENS WITH JOY
