NCF-ALIGNED ASSESSMENTS FOR HOLISTIC LEARNING

In line with the National Curriculum Framework (NCF), Meerut Public School, Pallavpuram has adopted a progressive approach to student's assessment by implementing both Formative and Summative assessments. This dual approach is designed to foster meaningful, stress-free learning while supporting the holistic development of every student.

Formative assessments are integrated into everyday learning experiences, offering timely feedback to support each student's progress.

Summative assessments provide a comprehensive evaluation of students' learning outcomes at the end of a learning period to assess their overall understanding and competence.

Together, these assessment methods aim to make learning more inclusive, developmental, and student-centered.

ELEVATE LEARNING : BLOOM'S ADVANTAGE

Meerut Public School Pallavpuram emphasis on Bloom's Taxonomy that classifies educational learning objectives into levels of complexity and specificity. It helps educators design curriculum and assessments that promote higher forms of thinking, such as analyzing and creating, rather than just remembering facts.

Six Levels of the Bloom's Taxonomy include

BTL 1- Remember :- Helps to Retrieve relevant knowledge from memory.

BTL 2- Understand - Helps to Construct meaning from instructional messages.

BTL 3- Apply - Helps to Use procedures in given situations.

BTL 4- Analyze - Helps to Break material into parts and understand its structure.

BTL 5- Evaluate - Helps to Make judgments based on criteria and standards.

BTL 6- Create - Helps to Put elements together to form a novel, coherent whole.

Bloom's Taxonomy Levels helps teachers to set clear, measurable objectives. It Encourages development of critical thinking skills, Guides the creation of assessments and activities and Supports differentiation in instruction for diverse learners.
